

PATIENT UPDATE

From Monday 29th June 2020 phase 2 will commence for the safe reopening of Dental Practices.

During this phase in addition **to URGENT DENTAL CARE** we have been providing over the last 3 months we are able to offer **NON URGENT DENTAL CARE**, however treatments are limited to those that are non-aerosol generating.

Non-Urgent Dental Conditions include:

- Mild dental trauma
- Moderate dental pain
- Moderate to severe caries
- Fractured, loose or debonded restorations with moderate pain
- Acute periodontal conditions
- Moderate to severe, currently unstable periodontitis
- Fractured, loose or debonded crowns, bridges, veneers
- Fractured loose dentures
- Denture additions and relines
- Fitting previously constructed dentures
- Patients in active orthodontic therapy who have not been reviewed for more than 12 weeks
- Fractured, loose or lost orthodontic appliances
- Preventative treatment
- Soft tissue lesions (not clinically suspicious of cancer)

We would appreciate your co-operation throughout this stage as there are several considerations to be taken into account whilst prioritising treatment:

- 1 Priority given to Urgent dental care needs
- 2 Decreased hours for each dentist as per social distancing guidelines
